The Community Strategies division of Community Resources for Justice supports more than 260 adults with developmental or intellectual disabilities through specialized residential and day programs in Massachusetts and New Hampshire.

Our impact in FY21

265 individuals lived happier, more independent lives through CRJ's programs for adults with developmental disabilities.

42 residential programs in Massachusetts and New Hampshire provided supportive home environments for individuals in our care.

50 individuals received services through our Shared Living program, which provides residential services in private homes with qualified providers.
